



Menlo College, in Atherton, will offer its Bachelor's degree in Management at Mission College for working adults with five years of work experience and at least 40 units of lower division courses. The program, offered in the evenings, allows students to earn a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science degree in Management in 20–24 months. The classes are all eight weeks in length, from 6:00 to 10:00 pm, and students go through the program one or two classes at a time.
