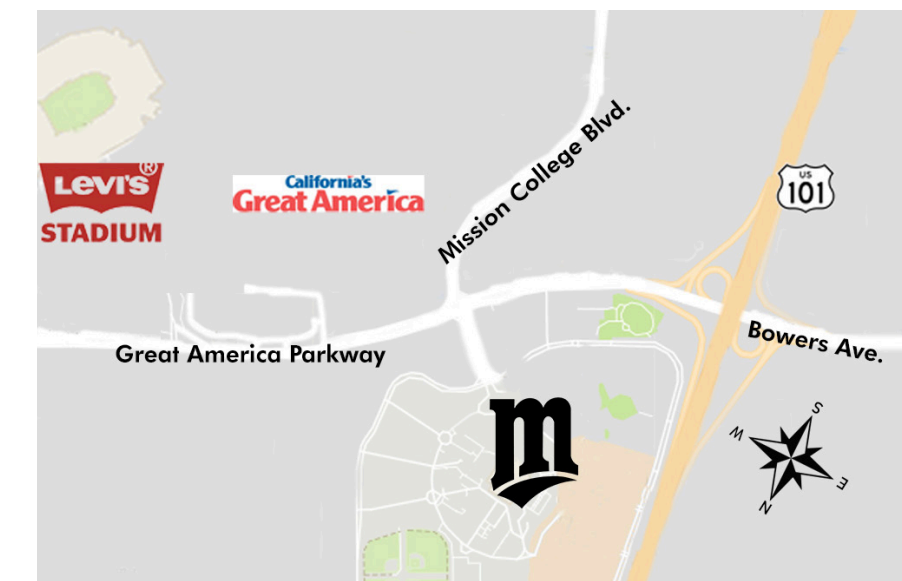


ABOUT MISSION COLLEGE

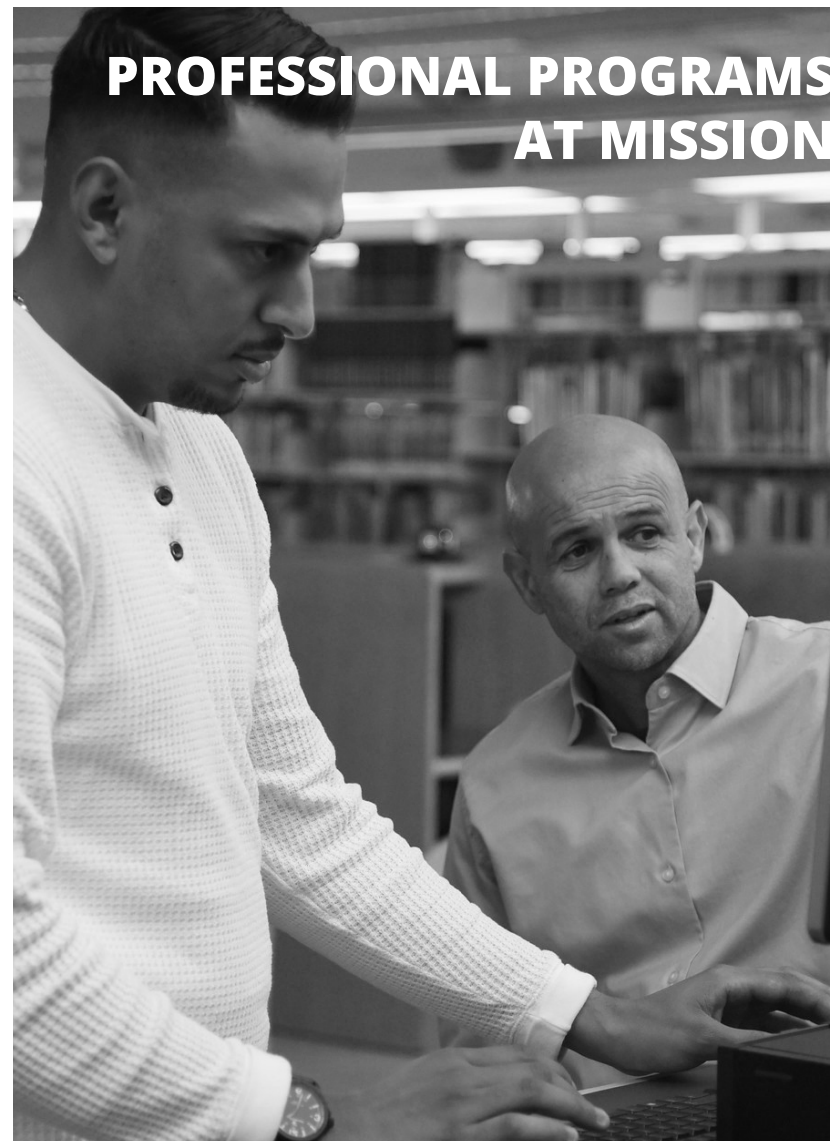

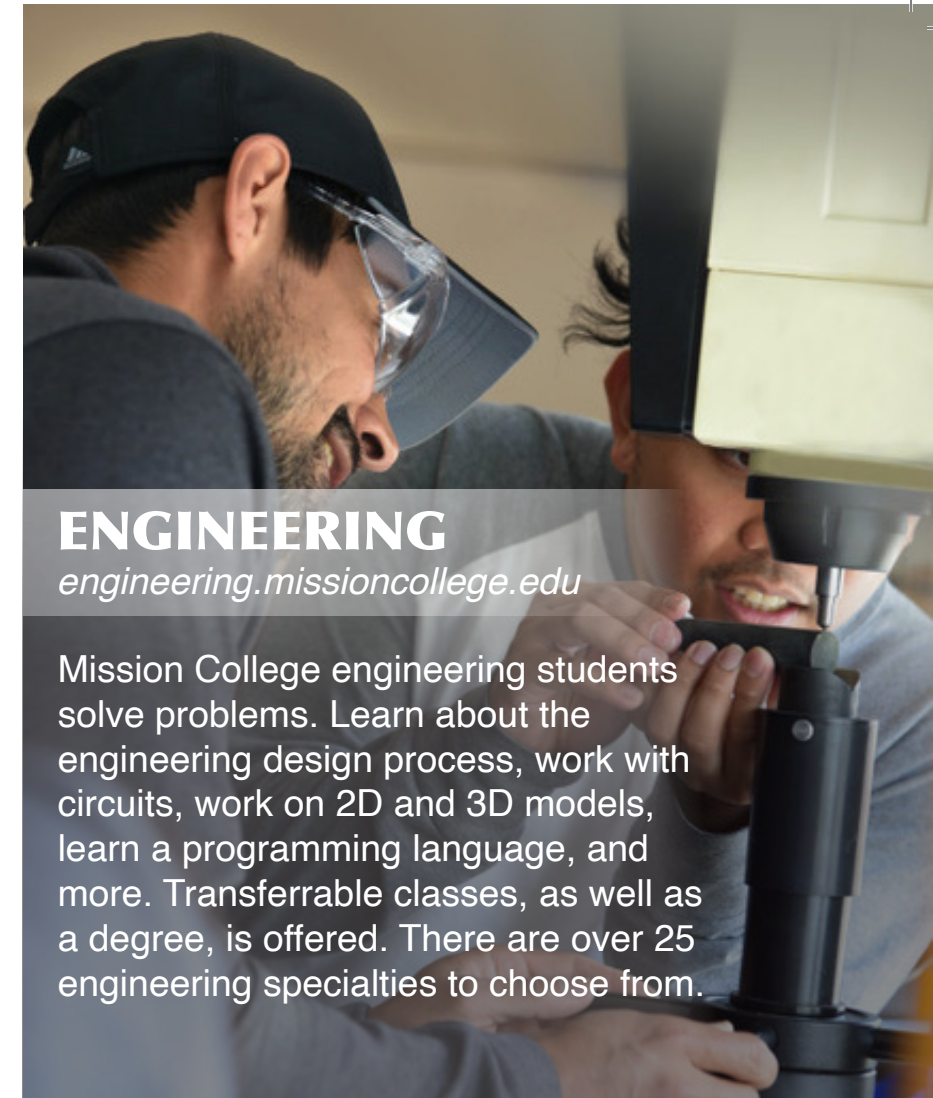

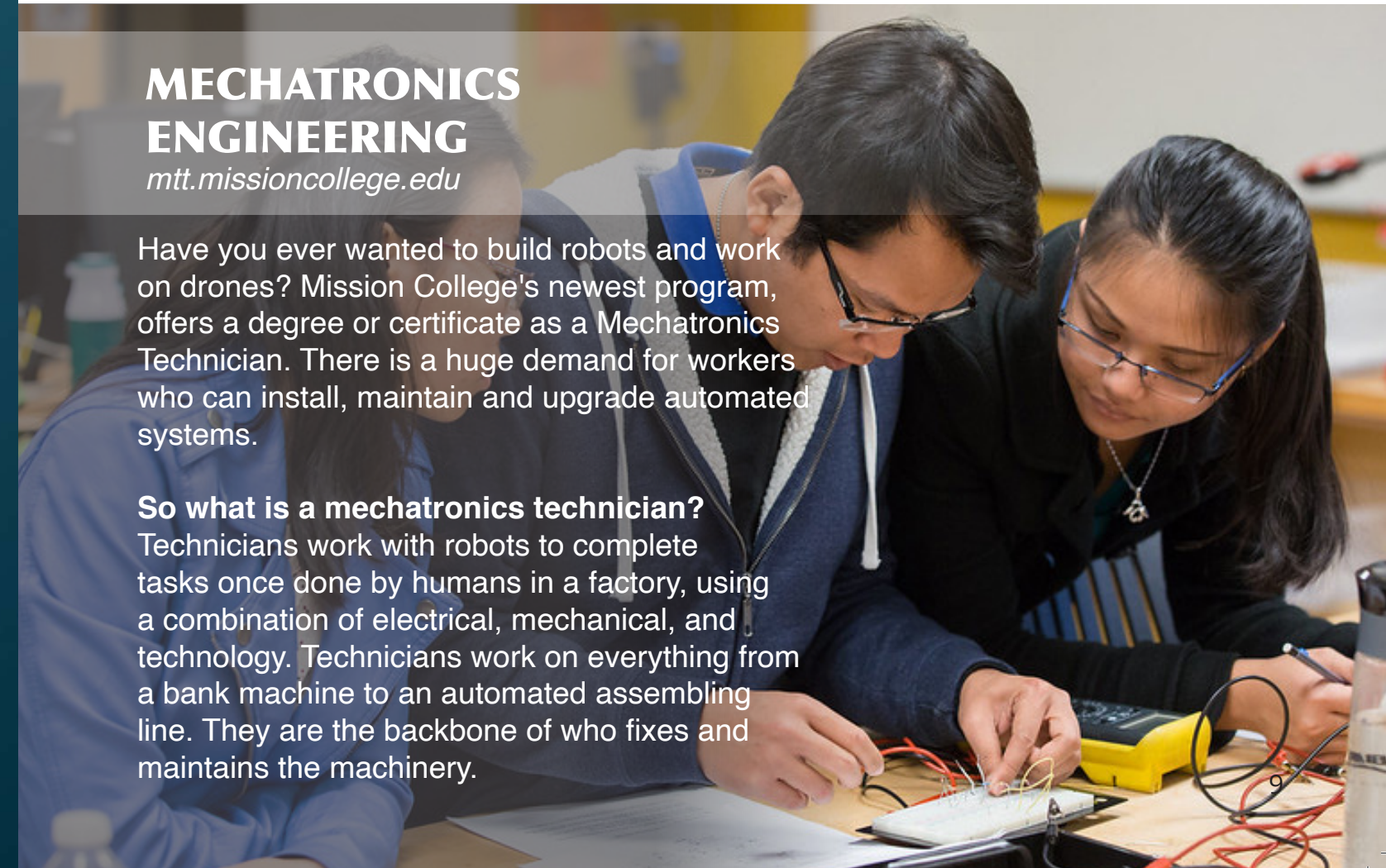
MECHATRONICS ENGINEERING

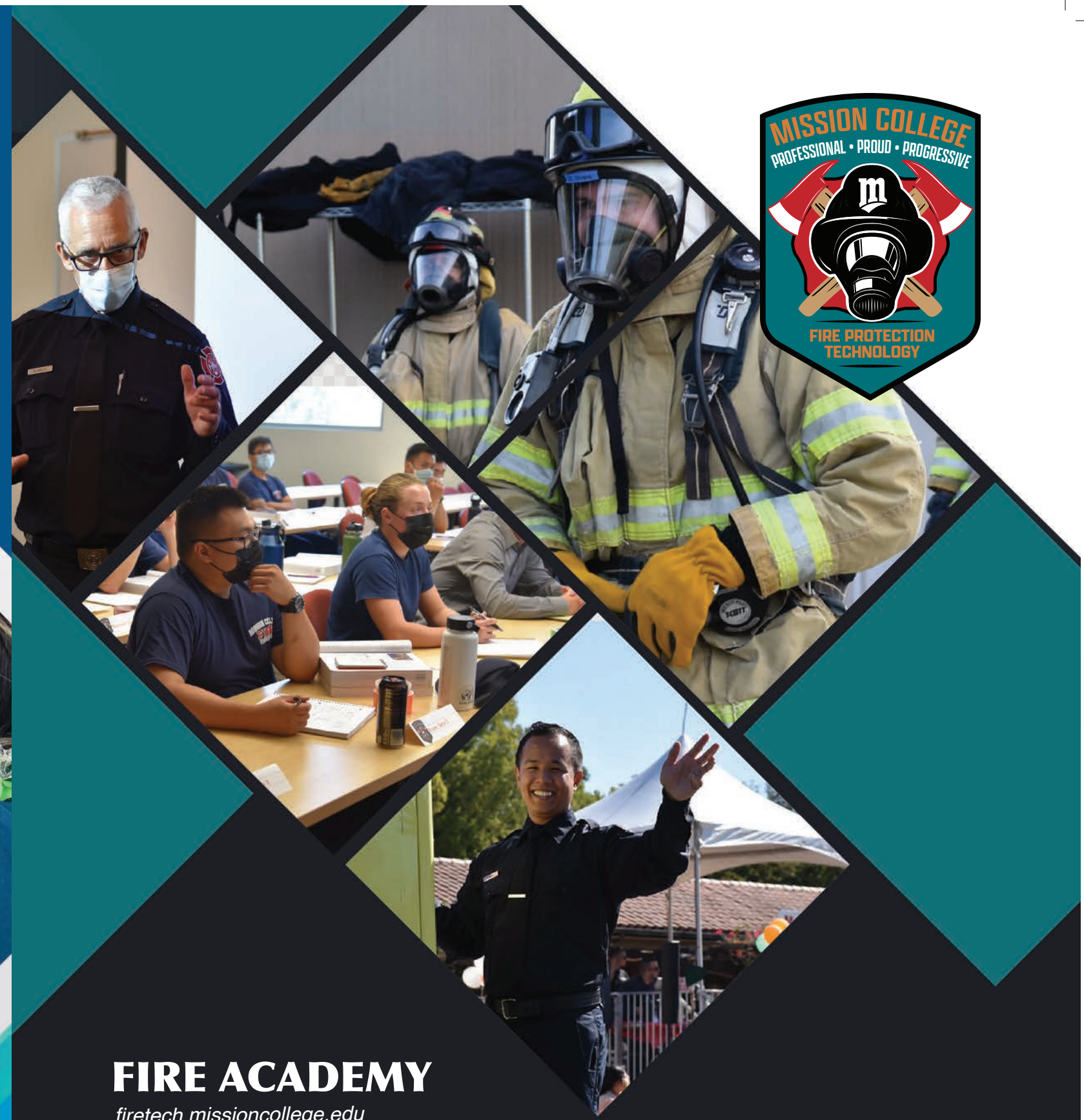

HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE CREDIT

Did you know high school students can earn college credits, while still in high school? And tuition fees are waived? Talk to your school counselor for details and to have them sign off on classes. Many high school students enroll in math, English, computer science, hospitality, graphic design, or business and accounting classes, receiving

hands-on training in a college environment. Students take four or six-week classes during the Winter and/or Summer, or during the semester. Some students have even completed a two-year degree **BEFORE** graduating high school. How does that sound towards future college costs?

1 APPLY FOR ADMISSION

- All students must submit an application to CCC Apply at apply.missioncollege.edu
- Explore college resource on MyPath.
- Consider submitting the application for Financial Aid. Visit financialaid.missioncollege.edu for more information.
- A student ID number and WVM email will be issued to you so you can register for classes.

2 DETERMINE YOUR PLACEMENT

- Visit the Placement and Assessment Services Center at placement.missioncollege.edu to the Placement Assistance Tool.
- If you have completed classes elsewhere or passed AP exams that you would like considered for course placement, visit prerequisites.missioncollege.edu

3 ATTEND ORIENTATION

- Set yourself up for success by completing the self-paced, online orientation available in the My Mission Portal with your WVM email address.
- Students wishing to get a more comprehensive orientation can register for COU 000A - Orientation to Mission College or COU 005, 023.

4 SELECT AND REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- Meet with a counselor to identify classes. Drop-in or schedule an appointment at counseling.missioncollege.edu.
- Go online to My Mission Portal at mywvm.wvm.edu to enroll in classes and pay fees.
- For assistance, go to welcomecenter.missioncollege.edu.

5 CREATE AN EDUCATIONAL PLAN

- Schedule a counseling appointment at the Counseling Center at counseling.missioncollege.edu.
- During the appointment students will create a Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP). Students can access their completed educational plans through DegreeWorks on the My Mission Portal.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION/ 3SP

In order to receive an early registration date, students must complete the following requirements from steps 2, 3 and 5 by the Priority Registration deadlines: Assessment, Orientation and Educational Plan as well as;

- Maintain good academic standing with at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA
- Complete at least 50% of your enrolled units each semester
- Students with over 100 units are not eligible for priority registration.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION DEADLINES: Summer/Fall 3rd Thursday in March Winter/Spring 3rd Thursday in October
