The campus' recent construction was made possible by the voters, who passed both Measures H (2004) and Measure C (2012) with 60 percent approvals each time. Measure H was a bond for \$235 million for the West Valley-Mission District, while Measure C approved an additional \$350 million. The Student Engagement Center replaces our Main Building, our first permanent building on campus, built in 1979. The SEC will house our services— Admissions, Assessment Center, Financial Aid and Counseling, International Center, Tutoring Center, Welcome Center and many other services to students. Along with classrooms and faculty offices, the building will also house much of our
