- 1. Do you need to test?** Click on [Alternatives to Testing](#) to see if you qualify for an exemption.
 - 2. Choose a math test and review.** Click on [Sample Tests](#) to choose a math test level, review sample tests, study packets and other test preparation materials.
 - 3. Check the testing schedule.** Click on [Assessment Center Test Schedule](#) to check available assessment times.
 - 4. Mark the tests you plan to take.** (English and math do not have to be taken on same day).
 - [ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE](#). **Allow two hours.** This test includes a multiple-choice section and a writing sample.
 - [ENGLISH](#). **Allow two hours.** This test includes three multiple-choice sections on reading, grammar and syntax.
 - [READING](#). **Allow one hour.** This test is only an option if you already have an English placement.
- [MATH](#). **Allow one to two hours** depending on which test you choose (includes a questionnaire and a tutorial.) Math tests #1, #2 and #3 are 45-minute timed tests. Test #4 is a 90-minute timed test. Choose one math test:
- [Test #1](#) tests arithmetic skills for placement into Math 900 (Arithmetic Functions), Math 902 (Pre-Algebra), Math 903 (Elementary Algebra), or Math 909 (Integrated Statistics). **Allow one hour.**
 - [Test #2](#) tests algebra skills for placement into Math C (Intermediate Algebra). **Allow one hour.**
 - [Test #3](#) tests intermediate algebra skills for placement into Statistics or Pre-Calculus. **Allow one hour.**
 - [Test #4](#) tests pre-calculus skills for placement into Pre-Calculus or Calculus). **Allow two hours.**
